# Who can nominate candidates for EULAR Committees?

The following groups are eligible to nominate candidates for EULAR's Committees, including suggestions for Chair positions:

### Eligible groups who can nominate candidates:

- Board
- Council
- Committee Members & Committee Chairs
- Ordinary Members (representatives of National Scientific Societies, National PARE Organisations, National HPR Organisations, Individual Members)

### The call for nominations closes on October 30th, 2025.

#### By-Laws 2.3 Nomination of the Members of the Committee

Before 1st December of each year, the Members of the Committee (Section 2.2), the members of the Chairmanship of the Committee (Section 4.4), the members of the EULAR Board, the members of the Council of EULAR and every Ordinary Member of EULAR may propose to the EULAR Board candidates to be nominated as Members of the Committee. Each nominated candidate will receive from the EULAR office an application form and must return it to the EULAR Board together with his/her CV and/or motivation letter highlighting the specific knowledge and experience useful for the Committee and a statement of conflict of interests.

#### By-Laws 4.4 Elections of the Chairmanship of the Committee

Before 1st December pf each year, the Members of the Committee (Section 2.2), the members of the Chairmanship of the Committee (Section 4.2), the members of the EULAR Board, the members of the Council of EULAR and every Ordinary Member of EULAR may propose to the EULAR Board candidates of the Chairmanship of the Committee. Each nominated candidate will receive from the EULAR office an application form and must return it to the EULAR Board together with his/her CV and/or motivation letter highlighting the specific knowledge and experience useful for the Committee and a statement of conflict of interests.



### How does the process work?

**Phase 1 - Nomination** 

Phase 2 – Application

Phase 3 - Final decision

### From 1 October to 30 October

- Eligible groups can <u>nominate</u> candidates for EULAR Committee positions.
- Nominations must be submitted via an online form that will be shared with the eligible groups by the EULAR Office.

### **Upon nomination, until 30 November**

- Each nominated candidate has to <u>apply</u> for the EULAR Committee position by submitting a CV and motivation letter.
- Individual EULAR members ("Blue Members") interested in a Committee position can directly apply, without being nominated.
- Applications must be submitted via a separate online form that will be shared by the EULAR Office.

### From 1 December to Spring 2026

- The Committee Chairs and the EULAR Board review all applications.
- New Committee members and Chairs are approved by the Board at their meeting in Spring 2026.
- The <u>new mandates start in June 2026</u>, after the EULAR Congress.

- Committee \*/\*\* 4 positions

- Chairmanship is a four-year term; first year as Chair-Elect, then two years as Chair, and one year as Past-Chair
- \*\* From experience, members of the Chairmanship are often elected from within the Committee. In such cases, a member seat becomes vacant, and EULAR welcomes nominations for a new Committee member
